The new rules make mandatory mask wearing applicable only to some healthcare workplaces and rescind the rules issued May 24th. The new rules are effective through December 22.

Per MIOSHA, with the change, non-healthcare employers are no longer required to maintain mask wearing, daily health screenings, and distancing measurers. Employers would have the option to use their own judgement but are encouraged to following existing Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and OSHA recommendations.
